STORMS RIVER VILLAGE

Roodezant Cabernet Sauvignon 2012

95

Beautifully crafted and not as heavily oaked as some. (1 year French oak) Ripe, soft blackcurrant flavours with hints of chocolate. Veritas silver award. Alc 13.5%

Fat Bastard Shiraz 2012

172

From the Robertson Cellar comes this full bodied beauty. Spice and ripe blackcurrant with a hint of woodsmoke. A lovely example of the cultivar with a long finish. Michelangelo Awards silver. Alc. 14%

Arabella Merlot 2013

125

Another soft, supple winner from the equestrian stud farm. Tomato concasse, plum and cherry spice...lovely body in a field of thin runners. Alc. 14%

Rooiberg Pinotage 2013

98

South Africa's own unique cultivar...packed with luscious blackberry flavours and balanced by harmonious oaking. A great all round food accompaniment. Alc. 14%

Goedverwacht Shiraz Rosé 2014

85

Delightful dry blusher from the award winning cellar...delicate hints of spice with a lovely tingle! Alc. 12.5%

WHITE WINES

Goedverwacht Good Earth Sauvignon Blanc 2014 105

Hints of cut grass, citrus and summer fruit...this delicious wine has a long, lingering finish...a real lip smacker! Alc. 12.5%

Van Loveren Sauvignon Blanc 2014 95

From the family owned estate near Robertson comes this delicious sauvignon...with hints of gooseberry and figs. Alc. 12.5%

Weltevrede Vanilla Chardonnay 2013 130

From Phillip Jonker, the Robertson area's chardonnay specialist. Lightly oaked to impart that type specific vanilla flavour. Hints of toast and summer fruit...a really lovely wine. Alc. 12.5%

Graham Beck Waterside Chardonnay 2014 125

A delicious unwooded chardonnay characteristic of the cultivar...citrus and tropical fruit with a long lingering finish. Alc.12.5%

Cloverfield Chenin Blanc 2014 85

Bold and vibrant! Brims with peaches, orange pith and pears (even a touch of grape!!) A lovely wine and great food partner. Alc.13%

500ml Rooiberg Chenin Blanc 2013 58

...just the trick if a full bottle is just a little too much! Dry, delightful and darned drinkable!! Alc. 12.5%cc

CONNOISSEUR'S CHOICE

This collection is selected in small quantities by the owners on their trips to the Robertson wine region. We trust that you will enjoy drinking them as much as we enjoyed choosing them!

Springfield Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 220

Fruit focussed cabernet employing the "whole berry" practice (gravity pressing) thereby avoiding crushing of stems and pips. Natural fermentation and loving care in the cellar then produces this superior wine by Abrie Bruwer. Alc.13.5%

Weltevrede Cigar Box Shiraz 2012 235

A superb wine! From a vineyard bedded in limestone, gravel and clay from the Jurassic period deemed perfect for shiraz. Dense, complex and refined, a tailored package of spice and fruit. French oak enhances vanilla characteristics. A real stunner. Alc. 13.5%

Robertson Phanto Ridge Pinotage 2013 210

South Africa's unique cultivar. Spiced mulberry fruit overlaid with banana, coffee and chocolate. Skilful use of French oak lends support and finesse with a nuance of vanilla on the nose and in the finish. One of the finest examples of the cultivar. Alc. 14%

Springfield Life from Stone Sauvignon Blanc 2014 195

A superb example of the winemakers art and a noble cultivar coming together in perfect harmony...citrus and ripe summer fruit with a delightful, lingering taste. Alc. 12.5%



SPARKLING WINE

The three sparkling wines below are made in the Methode Cap Classique style...that is in the French tradition of fermentation "en bouteille" and aged for at least one year with regular turning of the bottle (riddling) South African "Champagnes" have won world wide recognition, comparing well with and often exceeding French standards.

Bon Courage Jacques Bruere Brut Reserve 2009 220

Michelangelo Award (Silver) 2014. Elegantly stylish & crisp with a hint of lemon and creamy complexity on the palate. Fine lingering mouse and excellent finish. Alc.13.5%

Graham Beck Brut NV 195

From the *avant garde* cellar in the Robertson area, this stunner can compete with the best the French can throw at us! Beautifully crafted...remembered long after the last sip. Alc. 12.5%

Good Old Bubbly!

Rooiberg Brut NV 85

Fresh and lively mousse with very typical Sauvignon characteristics. A very well structured sparkler. The perfect partner for regular jollification...pop that cork now! Alc.11.5%
